

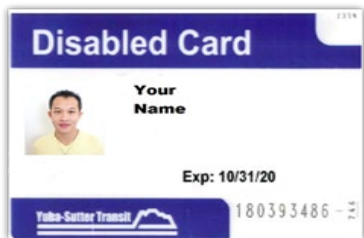


MARYSVILLE CHRISTMAS PARADE SATURDAY, DECEMBER 3RD

The 71st annual Marysville Christmas Parade returns to downtown Marysville at 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, December 3rd. With a theme of “Christmastime in Santa’s Workshop” this year, the parade will conclude a two-day holiday kick-off event in Historic Downtown Marysville which includes the annual tree-lighting ceremony at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, December 2nd.

On Saturday, D Street will be closed to vehicle traffic all day between First and Ninth Streets for parade set-up requiring Yuba-Sutter Transit to suspend service to the bus stops at D and Second Streets and F and Second Streets. The nearest available bus stops to downtown Marysville will be at Rideout Hospital on both sides of Third Street for Routes 1 and 4 and at B and Third Streets for Routes 4A and 4B.

REPLACE EXPIRING CONNECT CARDS

Discount photo-identification Connect Cards are typically issued for five years. Many are now beginning to expire and **need to be replaced before they expire because expired cards will not work**. Discount card holders (youth, seniors, and persons with disabilities) should regularly check the expiration date on their card to see if it is approaching. If so, bring your card to our Administrative Office during normal business hours where we will confirm your current information and issue you a new card (with a new picture) at no cost.

PLUMAS STREET TO CLOSE ON SATURDAY, DECEMBER 10TH

The annual “Christmas Stroll” will be on Saturday, December 10th from 2:00 – 8:00 p.m. in the Plumas Street Shopping District of Yuba City. The event will feature live entertainment, beautiful crafts, food vendors, and children’s activities all in the open air on vibrantly lit Plumas Street.

Yuba-Sutter Transit service will be re-routed from Plumas Street beginning at 10:00 a.m. to accommodate the festivities. Route 1 buses will operate on Olive Street between Colusa and Forbes Avenues and Route 2 will operate on Shasta Street between Colusa Avenue and Bridge Street. The Plumas Street bus stops at Church and Bridge Streets and the Forbes Avenue stops at Almond Street will not be in service during this time.

OLIVEHURST CHRISTMAS PARADE TO CLOSE A PORTION OF OLIVEHURST AVENUE SATURDAY, DECEMBER 10TH

Holiday cheer will return to Olivehurst on Saturday, December 10th for the 53rd edition of the Olivehurst Christmas Parade for the families and friends of South Yuba County. The parade, which is scheduled to begin at 11:00 a.m., will travel on Olivehurst Avenue from 9th Avenue to 5th Avenue.

Street closures on the parade route are scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m. and end when the parade ends. During the street closure, Yuba-Sutter Transit's Route 3 service will be detoured in both directions from Olivehurst Avenue to Western Avenue between 10th and 3rd Avenues. Service will resume on Olivehurst Avenue when the street is cleared for traffic.

SERVICE NOTES

DARK & DREARY WEATHER – Less daylight hours combined with the wet and foggy conditions that are common this time of year make it difficult for commuter and even local buses to remain on schedule at times. If such delays are likely to cause a problem for you, please consider riding an earlier schedule.

NO SMOKING WITHIN 20' OF ANY YUBA-SUTTER TRANSIT BUS, STOP, BENCH OR SHELTER – Winter weather also tends to push people closer together so remember that smoking of any kind is expressly prohibited within 20' of any Yuba-Sutter Transit bus, bus stop, bus stop bench or bus stop shelter.

SEAT ETIQUETTE – Speaking of winter weather, please do not put your wet belongings (or feet) on vacant seats for any reason. The next person who sits in that seat (and it might be you) does not want a soggy surprise.

LOST & FOUND – We are not responsible for what you leave behind on the bus, but check with us before you give up on your umbrella, cell phone, sunglasses, etc. Found items are removed from buses at the end of each service day. Non-perishable items are kept for at least 30 days after which time they are subject to donation to a non-profit organization of our choice. So, if you think you lost something on the bus, call our Administration Office at (530) 634-6880.

ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE HOURS – The customer service counter in the Yuba-Sutter Transit Administrative Office at 2100 B Street in Marysville is open weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to Noon and from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Please note that we are closed for lunch except by appointment.

CHRISTMAS GIFT GUIDE & CONNECT CARD SALES OUTLETS

For a practical and useful gift idea, try loading the Connect Cards of your bus riding friends and loved ones with a monthly pass or cash value this year – a gift that keeps on giving! Just bring the nine-digit number from the back of their Connect Card to our office and we can load it with cash or passes right there. Cards can hold up to \$360 in cash value and/or passes for up to three months.

You can load your own Connect Card at any of the sales outlets below or on the Connect Card website. New full fare Connect Cards are available from any sales outlet, but new and replacement discount photo ID Connect Cards are only available during normal weekday business hours at the Yuba-Sutter Transit Administrative Office in Marysville.
