**YUBA-SUTTER TRANSIT AUTHORITY
JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT AMENDMENT #1**

This first amendment ("Amendment") to that certain Joint Powers Agreement for the Yuba-Sutter Transit Authority effective March 1, 2002 is made and entered into with an effective date of May 1, 2015 by and between the Counties of Yuba and Sutter, political subdivisions of the State of California, and the Cities of Marysville and Yuba City, municipal corporations.

RECITALS

Since July of 1975 the parties have been members of a Joint Powers Agreement formed for the purpose of providing and furnishing transit and transportation services within their respective jurisdictions.

This Joint Powers Agreement has been amended from time to time most recently effective March 1, 2002.

The entity which was created by the parties is currently known as the Yuba-Sutter Transit Authority ("the Authority").

The current version of the Joint Powers Agreement concerning the Authority contains a formula, specified in paragraph 5 of such Agreement, whereby the Annual Local Transportation Fund (PUC 99230) contribution of the parties is determined using a formula in which four factors are given equal weight.

One of the four factors is the Service Area Population for each of the members as specified in paragraph 5(a) of the current Joint Powers Agreement.

The source of population data specified in paragraph 5(a) of the current Joint Powers Agreement utilized the latest Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) population module which is no longer available.

This Amendment is technical in nature and the Authority shall be construed as having been in continual existence since its creation and no action previously exercised by the Authority shall be deemed to be modified, amended or otherwise affected by this Amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing facts and circumstances and mutual promises and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Incorporation of Recitals. The foregoing recitals are contractual in nature and are incorporated into this Amendment.

2. Modification of Section 5(a) of the Current Joint Powers Agreement for the Yuba Sutter Transit Authority dated December 17, 2001. Paragraph 5(a) of the Joint Powers Agreement for the Yuba Sutter Transit Authority dated December 17, 2001 is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

“(a) Service Area Population. One-fourth of the total contribution of each member entity shall be based on the ratio that the total service area population of each entity bears to the total population of the Authority’s adopted service area. Population for each entity shall be as determined by the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) from the latest City/County Population and Housing Estimates available prior to the adoption of the budget for the ensuing fiscal year. Exceptions to the use of the City/County Population and Housing Estimates shall be made when major annexations have occurred since the last City/County Population and Housing Estimates was published. In the case of such exceptions, the best population data available shall be used. In the event the City/County Population and Housing Estimates cease to be maintained, the Authority’s Board of Directors may by duly

adopted resolution designate another suitable database to be utilized for the purpose of determining the service area population for each member entity.”

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have entered into this Amendment effective May 1, 2015 and have executed this Amendment on the dates set forth below.
